
IT'S SO NICE TO "MEET" YOU

THIS IS OUR STORY





GOATS: Billy, Gandalf, Totes, and PB are clowns and always entertain us. They are gentle with people and always run around and play together in the yard.






OUR HOME


BEFORE YOU GO...
